

Dear Student,

Our records show that you are registered with your high school for an English class that offers Concurrent Enrollment college credit through Utah Valley State College. By meeting the qualifications outlined below, you would be eligible to receive both high school and college credit by successfully completing this class.

The Concurrent Enrollment English classes are accelerated and challenging classes. There may be additional work involved to receive the college credit. Your high school teacher will assign both the high school and college grades, which may be different. A permanent college transcript will be generated if you enroll in the Concurrent Enrollment program. The credit earned is through UVSC and this credit is transferable to all state colleges as well as to BYU and BYU Idaho. It is your responsibility to learn how credit will be transferred. There is no tuition or textbook fees required. A one-time \$35.00 application fee is the only financial obligation.

Requirements to enroll in a Concurrent Enrollment English class are as follows:

- English 1010 students must be high school seniors **NO EXCEPTIONS**.
- English 1010 students must have a 3.0 GPA in 10<sup>th</sup> and 11<sup>th</sup> grade English classes.
- English 1010 students must have an English ACT score of 19 or higher and a Reading ACT score of 19 or higher. You may substitute this score with a UVSC Compass assessment test score. In which case a score of 77 or higher in DRP (Reading) and a score of 80 or higher in CSW (Writing) are required.
- The testing center is in the Wolverine Service Center at the northwest end of campus on 1165 W 800 S (the old ALLC portables). The first test is free of charge. All subsequent tests are \$10.00 per section. Call 863-8269 for testing hours and take your social security number along with a photo ID. Your test results will be immediate.
- **Before taking the assessment test, make sure you have applied online so you are in the computer system.** You do not need to pay any application fee at this time.

**Please take copies of necessary prerequisites to your high school UVSC Concurrent Enrollment site coordinator before the beginning of the semester. These requirements may not be submitted after taking a Concurrent Enrollment English class granting the student credit retroactively.**

If you are interested in taking this or any other Concurrent Enrollment class, and you have never taken a Concurrent Enrollment class before, you can apply online at [www.uvsc.edu/concurrent](http://www.uvsc.edu/concurrent) and apply to be a student of UVSC.
