CREDIT PROGRAMS 2003-04

- Evening School Summer Enrollment is up 2.37%
- Individualized Associate Degree now available at North Valley and Spanish Fork Education Centers in Spring 2004
- Wasatch Campus student population increased by 13%
- 2-year Associate of Science Degree in Behavioral Science available at Wasatch Campus
- BYU is accepting Concurrent Enrollment credits

NON-CREDIT PROGRAMS 2003-04

- **Community Education**—Over 400 classes for approx. 5400 students at 8 locations in Utah Valley
- **Elderhostel**—32 programs this year with highest number of enrollments ever
- **Equity in Education**—111 workshops presented to 67 different groups for total of 6502 participants, total of 11,324 participant hours
- **Turning Point**—Distinguished Program Award for Non-Credit Programs from ACHE
- **Turning Point**--\$400,000 of federal money appropriated
