All correspondence will be sent to your UVLink account.

Men of ages 18 through 25 are required to register with the Selective Service system. If you are a male student who failed to register with Selective Service before your 26th birthday, you must 1) provide documentation which clearly shows that you were exempt from Selective Service registration **or** 2) prove to the Financial Aid Appeals Committee that your non-registration was not *knowing and willful*. Please carefully review the following information, select the statement which correctly identifies your situation, and submit documentation as directed.

Non-citizens who first entered the U.S. after they turned 26

, Provide a Status Information Letter from Selective Service that verifies that you were not required to register; **or** provide documentation of your entrance into the U.S. after age 26; **or** prove to the Financial Aid Appeal Committee that your non-registration was not knowing and willful by submitting additional documentation regarding the nature of, and reasons for, your failure to register.

Non-citizens who entered the U.S. as lawful non-immigrants on a valid visa and remained in the U.S. on the terms of that visa until after they turned 26

, Provide a Status Information Letter from Selective Service that verifies that you were not required to register **or** prove to the Financial Aid Appeal Committee that your non-registration was not knowing and willful by submitting additional documentation regarding the nature of, and reasons for, your failure to register.

U.S. Citizens who were required to register with Selective Service but failed to do so

, Provide a Status Information Letter from Selective Service; **and** prove to the Financial Aid Appeal Committee that your non-registration was not knowing and willful by submitting additional documentation regarding the nature of, and reasons for, your failure to register. You should provide a complete description about your situation, such as where you were living during the period when you should have registered, whether you were incarcerated or institutionalized, your citizenship status during the period, etc.

Other

, If you believe that you are exempt from Selective Service registration, or would like to appeal your failure to register, due to a reason not listed above, please visit with a Financial Aid advisor to determine the appropriate course of action and necessary documentation.
