

Utah Valley State College Study Abroad in

Taiwan



Program Details: Designed for students pursuing a degree or employment in healthcare or for those interested in traditional Chinese medicine and Buddhist philosophies/teachings, this program *explores healthcare in Taiwan!*

Students will learn about the professional practice of healthcare providers and the healthcare system, traditional Chinese medicine, interventions, and strategies for combining traditional healthcare practices with Western medicine.

Students will have many opportunities for *cultural immersion* and will explore political, historical, and scenic sites. Program participants will experience the excitement of Taipei, a large metropolitan area, to Pan Wu, a small coastal community.

Tentative Dates: May 5 to June 18, 2008 (Travel to Taiwan: May 16 to June 5, 2008)

Program Sites: Taipei, Tainan, Taichung, Pan Wu, Hua Lien, and others.

Anticipated curriculum: Nursing 490R (Special Topics in Nursing) and Nursing 495R (Independent Study). Students register for 8 credit hours. Non-nursing students may participate; special topics or independent study credit from other departments is available.

Estimated participation fee: \$2,295. Apply by January 28, 2008, and **save \$300**. Estimated fee for early applicants: **\$1,995**.

Submit application, photos, transcript, two letters of reference, \$75 non-refundable application fee, and \$300 program deposit. If you miss the deadline, you are still welcome to apply until the program is full, but please note that the participation fee will be higher and *program space is limited*.

Financial aid: Pell grants and Federal Insured Student Loans may be applied to this program, based on eligibility. Applicants must have a current FAFSA form on file at the Financial Aid Office (BA105) and complete all necessary application forms for financial aid.
